LEE MARSHALL'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY

On October 23, 2019, Sheriff Jay Koon recognized Captain Lee Marshall with a 25-Year Honorable Service Award.

The Lexington County Sheriff's Department hired Lee C. Marshall as a patrol deputy on August 8, 1994, and he quickly rose through the ranks, becoming a Master Deputy in 1998, then transferring into Major Crimes, as an investigator, in 1999. In 2004, Marshall became a Sergeant in Investigations, and then in 2009, he became the Inspector for the Lexington County Sheriff's Department. In 2012, from his position as Inspector, Lee Marshall was promoted to the rank of Captain and currently serves as the Commander of the Administrative Division of the Lexington County Sheriff's Department.

Capt. Marshall has received numerous awards during his 25 years of honorable service, to include: 2 Meritorious Achievement Awards, 2 Meritorious Conduct Awards, 3 Community Service Awards, and the Educational Achievement Award.
